The factory building was over the years owned and operated by International Shoes, Bali, Lisbon Shoes, and Rosita Shoe;

At one time over 300 were employed at the Whitcher Street factory;

In 1995 the last women's leather footwear in New Hampshire was manufactured at the Whitcher Street factory;
